This Is to Certify, That EMIL AND IRENE HOERAUF

of Star Rt. 1 Box 192, Lacomb, State of Oregon, 97354, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-45301. Permit No. R-5345 a tributary of Crabtree Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 11.7 acres

and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in under Permit No. 33824 accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.15 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Swk NWk, Section 18, T. 11 S., R. 1 E., W. M., Stream-1670 feet South and 270 feet East; Reservoir-1520 feet South and 110 feet East; both from the NW Corner, Section 18.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 24 acre feet per acre for each scre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-5345,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 6.9 acres NWt NWt 4.8 acres SWE NWE Section 18 T. 11 S., R. 1 E., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
