## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

of 985 Lillian Way, Sebastipol , State of California, 95472 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Skookum Lake

a tributary of an unnamed stream, trib. of Willamette River irrigation of 50.9 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 34843 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 2, 1970

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.64 cubic foot per second** 

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SM SEL, as projected within Waggoner DLC 66, Section 32, T. 3 S., R. 2 W., W. M., 1280 feet South and 360 feet East from the NW Corner of Waggoner DLC 66.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further, limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

10.2 acres NW4 SE4 11.2 acres SW4 SE4 14.0 acres SE4 SE4 All projected within Waggoner DLC 66 Section 32 T. 3 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

15.5 acres NEk NEk As projected within Waggoner DLC 39 Section 5 T. 4 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
