CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **JAMES BEYER**

of **At. 2 Box 152, Silverton**, State of **Oregon, 97361**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-48631, Permit No. R-5815 a tributary of **Pudding River** for the purpose of fish culture and irrigation of **16.7 acres**

under Permit No. **35962** and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **July 8, 1971** that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.25 cubic foot per second, being 0.04 cubic foot per second for fish culture and 0.21 cubic foot per second for irrigation**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, T. 6 S., R. 1 W., W. M., Dam-660 feet South and 1160 feet West from the NE Corner of Section 29.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-5815,**

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

**Fish culture and 16.7 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 29
T. 6 S., R. 1 W., W. M.**

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
