CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

ERNEST F. HEESACKER

of Rt. 1 Box 294 H, Forest Grove, State of Oregon, 97116, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a well

a tributary of West Fork Dairy Creek for the purpose of fish culture, irrigation of 33.6 acres, and supplemental irrigation of 18.9 acres

under Permit No. G-5005 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 1, 1971

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.46 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for fish culture and 0.45 c.f.s. for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 14, T. 1 N., R. 4 W., W. M., 1250 feet North and 290 feet West from the S $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner of Section 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
