CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

EDWIN D. COLLINS

of Star Rt. Box 195, Winston, State of Oregon, 97496, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Lookingglass Creek

a tributary of South Umpqua River
irrigating 10.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 785 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 1, 1911 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.13 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Gage DLC 51, Section 20, T. 28 S., R. 6 W., W. M., 50 feet South and 3050 feet East, SW Corner of J. Cox DLC 49.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ~~one-eightieth~~ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.7 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
3.6 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
4.9 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
0.6 acre NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$

All projected within J. Cox DLC 49
Section 20
T. 28 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion and place of use approved by an order of the State Engineer entered January 3, 1973, and supersedes certificate of water right issued to T. A. Carpenter and recorded at Page 832, Volume 1, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
