## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** (MRS.) J. H. KLOPE

of Rt. 1 Box 32, Riddle, State of Oregon, 97469, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Council Creek

a tributary of Cow Creek for the purpose of domestic use and irrigation of 0.5 acre

under Permit No. 18582 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 15, 1948

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.017 cubic foot per second, being 0.007 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic use

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 33, T. 30 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-seventieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1st to October 1st of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic Use and 0.5 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 33  
T. 30 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by an order of the State Engineer entered February 1, 1973, and along with certificate 39216 supersedes certificate of water right issued to (Mrs.) J. H. Klope and recorded at Page 19886, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
