## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** DON C. MAY

of Windy Creek Road, Box 4, Glendale, State of Oregon, 97442, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Windy Creek

a tributary of Cow Creek for the purpose of irrigating 1.8 acres

under Permit No. 27344 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 18, 1961

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 27, T. 32 S., R. 6 W., W. M., 10 feet South and 1100 feet East from the W $\frac{1}{2}$  Corner of Section 27.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to the use of water shall be limited to the period when the flow of Cow Creek is more than 11 cubic feet per second at its mouth;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.8 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 27  
T. 32 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered September 24, 1973, and along with certificate 39826 supersedes certificate of water right issued to The Robert Dollar Company and recorded at Page 37267, Volume 29, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
