## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

MARY K. FORSTER

of P.O. Box 365, Sutherlin , State of Oregon, 97479 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Calapooya Creek

a tributary of Umpqua River irrigating 50.29 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 23412 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 3, 1955

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.62 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SWk SEk, as projected within Stephens DLC 50, Section 15, T. 25 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

aná shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

10.3 acres NE% SW%
5.1 acres SE% SW%
24.9 acres NW% SE%
9.99 acres SW% SE%
All projected within Stephens DLC 50
Section 15
T. 25 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

An order of the State Engineer entered April 2, 1975 approved a change in point of diversion for the irrigation of 9.31 acres. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right not involved in the change and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Mary K. Forster recorded at Page 41917, Volume 33, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
