CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **DONNE NERELL**

of Rt. 1 Box 80, Oakland, State of Oregon, 97462, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Pollock Creek

a tributary of Calapooya Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 10.7 acres

under Permit No. 25938 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 19, 1958

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.14 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 15, T. 24 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ~~one-eightieth~~ of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to the use of water is limited to the period when the flow of the water in the Calapooya Creek is 12 c.f.s. or more at its mouth;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.4 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
6.4 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
2.9 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 15
T. 24 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

An order of the State Engineer entered May 6, 1974 approved a change in point of diversion for the irrigation of 3.4 acres. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right not involved in the change and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Donne Nerell recorded at Page 32287, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
