; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1907;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed the rate of one cubic foot of water per second of time for each 70 acres of land irrigated during the irrigation season.

The point of diversion is located in the NE's SE's, Section 4, T. 33 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.1 acre SEk NEk 2.0 acres NEk SEk Section 4 T. 33 %., R. 6 W., W. M.

An order of the Water Resources Director entered December 19, 1975 approved a change in point of diversion for the irrigation of 5.5 acres. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right not involved in the change and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Andrew Pete Tacorded at Page 9662, Volume 9, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy
