A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

11.6 acres SW4 SE4 Section 11 T. 1 N., R. 19 E., W. M.

Rock Creek:

1/40 cubic foot per second per acre irrigated to June 1 and 1/80 cubic foot per second per acre thereafter; further limited to one acre foot per calendar month to June 1 and four acre feet per acre during season April 1 to September 30, measured at point of diversion.

John Day River:

1/40 cubic foot per second per acre irrigated from April 1 to September 30; further limited to one acre foot per acre per calendar month; total of five acre feet per acre for season, measured at point of diversion.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered March 29, 1971 and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to M. F. Duncan and recorded at Page 25116, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy
