CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

V. O. WEST

of Arlington, State of Oregon, 97812, has
 a right to the use of the waters of
 Rock Creek and John Day River

a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of
 irrigating 11.6 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
 Grant County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
 the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 15, at page 461; that the priority of the
 right thereby confirmed dates from 1869

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
 amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

The point of diversion is located in the Rock Creek - SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 11, T. 1 N.,
 R. 19 E., W. M., 4820 feet South and 2170 feet West from the NE Corner of Section 11.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
 follows:

11.6 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
 Section 11
 T. 1 N., R. 19 E., W. M.

Rock Creek:

1/40 cubic foot per second per acre irrigated to June 1 and 1/80 cubic foot
 per second per acre thereafter; further limited to one acre foot per calendar
 month to June 1 and four acre feet per acre during season April 1 to September 30,
 measured at point of diversion.

John Day River:

1/40 cubic foot per second per acre irrigated from April 1 to September 30;
 further limited to one acre foot per acre per calendar month; total of five
 acre feet per acre for season, measured at point of diversion.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved
 by an order of the State Engineer entered March 29, 1971 and supersedes
 certificate of water right heretofore issued to M. F. Duncan and recorded at
 Page 25116, Volume 17, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
 The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
 use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established
 by the Water Policy Review Board.
