CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CARL TAYLOR AND LYNN TAYLOR

of Rt. 3, Hood River, State of Oregon, 97031, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream branch of Indian Creek

a tributary of Hood River for the purpose of irrigation of 3.0 acres

under Permit No. 5059 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 9, 1921 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 4, T. 2 N., R. 10 E., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighth of one cubic foot per second per acre.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.0 acres SE 1/4 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 4 T. 2 N., R. 10 E., W. M.

An order of the State Engineer entered March 4, 1974 approved a change in point of diversion for the irrigation of 4.0 acres. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right not involved in the change and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Carl Taylor and Lynn Taylor recorded at Page 3802, Volume 5, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
