## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** WAYNE H. AND BERTHA O. SAFLEY

of 315 N. Phoenix Road, Medford, State of Oregon, 97501, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of irrigation of 9.3 acres

under Permit No. 3013 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 2, 1916 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.12 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 2 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ), Section 29, T. 35 S., R. 1 W., W. M., 2300 feet South and 680 feet West from the N $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner of Section 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

9.3 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 29  
T. 35 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered October 24, 1973 and along with Transfer 2919 supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to James C. Luce and recorded at Page 31333, Volume 23, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
