## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That** ROBERT A. EMBLETON

of 33372 Marina Vista Drive, Dana Point, State of California, 92629, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Evans Creek

a tributary of Rogue River for the purpose of irrigating 17.0 acres

under Permit No. 4920 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 21, 1920 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.21 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 3, T. 35 S., R. 3 W., W. M., 340 feet South and 680 feet West from the NE Corner, NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 3.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

15.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 3  
2.0 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 4  
T. 35 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered January 28, 1974, and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to Ransom Carter, and recorded at Page 4872, Volume 5, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
