CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

THEODORE, ELDORA, LEO, AND ROSE BLOOMBERG

of LB Star Route, Box 188, Eagle Point , State of Oregon, 97524 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Long Branch and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-30443, Permit No. R-1803

a tributary of Little Butte Creek irrigating 52.4 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 23906 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 25, 1955

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.66 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the NW2 SW2, Section 18, T. 36 S., R. 2 E., W. M.,

Diversion point located 910 feet South and 630 feet East from the W2 Corner of

Section 18.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1803;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

16.1 acres NE's SE's Section 13 T. 36 S., R. 1 E., W. M. 18.1 acres NW SW SW 18.2 acres SW SW SW Section 18
T. 36 S., R. 2 E., W. M.

An order of the State Engineer entered September 19, 1974 approved a change in place of use for the irrigation of 5.6 acres. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right not involved in the change and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Rose, Leo, Theodore, Eldora Bloomberg recorded at Page 35740, Volume 27, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein lescribed, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
