CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

CORA B. CRUMP, ADMINISTRATRIX OF THE ESTATE OF J. F. CRUMP, DECEASED

of Buncom, State of Oregon, 97530, has a right to the use of the waters of Yale Creek, or Right Fork of Little Applegate River

a tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of irrigating 61.1 acres and the development of 4 horsepower

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1865 for 0.74 c.f.s. for irrigation of 29.6 acres; 1880 for 0.63 c.f.s. for irrigation of 25.0 acres; 1907 for 0.16 c.f.s. for * that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.68 cubic feet per second.

* irrigation of 6.5 acres, domestic and stock use; and 1907 for 0.15 c.f.s. for Farm Power Wheel

The point of diversion is located in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 29, T. 39 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 7.1 acres SE 1/4 NE 1/4
19.0 acres NW 1/4 SE 1/4
31.0 acres NE 1/4 SE 1/4
Section 29
4.0 acres NW 1/4 SW 1/4
Section 28
T. 39 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

An order of the Water Resources Department entered April 20, 1976 approved a change in place of use for the irrigation of 0.4 acres. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right not involved in the change and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Cora B. Crump, Administratrix of the Estate of J. F. Crump, deceased, recorded at Page 16415, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
