a tributary of Pacific Ocean irrigating 7.57 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 8386 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 16, 1928

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.142 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW2 SW2, Section 16; SE2 SE2, Section 17, T. 36 S., R. 3 W., W. M., North 58 degrees East 550 feet From the SW Corner of Section 16; 830 feet North and 1719.61 feet East; 875 feet North and 1619.61 feet East; both from the St Corner of Section 17.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

4.3 acres SWk SWk Section 16 0.52 acre SW SE 2.75 acres SE% SE% Section 17 T. 36 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

An order of the Water Resources Director entered February 3, 1976 approved a change in point of diversion for the irrigation of 0.5 acre and an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 4, 1976 approved a change in point of diversion for the irrigation of 0.5 acre. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right not involved in the changes and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to Soren M. Christensen, Wayne J. Bateman, and Mart A. Williams recorded at Page 39594, Volume 31, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described. and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review goard.
