of Box 866, Medford , State of oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Rogue River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean irrigating 18.9 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 1566 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 22, 1913

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.236 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 2 (NEL), Section 19, T. 36 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightleth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

18.9 acres Lot 3 (SE\(\) N\(\) N\(\) Section 19
T. 36 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

An order of the Water Resources Director entered April 19, 1976 approved a change in point of diversion for the irrigation of 1.1 acres. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right not involved in the change and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to H. B. Nye recorded at Page 1806, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
