## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

CHARLES M. AND EDNA A. HOYT

of 560 Caves Camp Road, Williams, State of Oregon, 97544, has  
a right to the use of the waters of  
West Fork Williams Creek

a tributary of Williams Creek for the purpose of  
irrigating 12.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the  
right thereby confirmed dates from 1900

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.20 cubic foot per  
second

The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 8, T. 39 S., R. 5 W., W. M.,  
1780 feet South and 550 feet East from the NW Corner of Section 8.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:

10.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
2.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 8  
T. 39 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved  
by an order of the State Engineer entered March 22, 1966, and along with  
certificate recorded at Page 39598, Volume 31 and certificate 41653, Volume 33,  
supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to J. N. Larimore  
and recorded at Page 16323, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.  
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established  
by the Water Policy Review Board. WITNESS the signature of the Water Resources Director, affixed

this date August 30, 1976.
