CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **CLAUDIS L. FRYE**

492 Donaldson Ave.
of Rockaway Beach, Pacifica , State of California, 94044 , has made
proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of
Wolf Creek

a tributary of Grave Creek for the purpose of
irrigating 0.4 acre

under Permit No. 19386 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in
accordance with the law of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from
April 18, 1950
that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.005 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 22, T. 33 S., R. 6 W., W. M.,
650 feet South and 1730 feet East from the NW Corner of Section 22.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to
a diversion of not to exceed 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the
irrigation season from April 2 to October 31 of each year,

and shall
conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right
is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.4 acre NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 22
T. 33 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of
diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered May 24, 1972,
and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to Jessie L. Harris
and recorded at Page 20864, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies
established by the Water Policy Review Board.
