## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

GUY FETTERLY

of Kerby  
a right to the use of the waters of  
East Fork Illinois River

, State of Oregon, 97531, has

a tributary of Illinois River  
irrigating 33.2 acres

for the purpose of

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for  
Josephine County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of  
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 13, at page 70; that the priority of the  
right thereby confirmed dates from 1857

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an  
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one cubic foot per  
second from each 50 acres of land irrigated during the irrigation season from  
April 1 to November 1 of each year.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 14, T. 40 S., R. 8 W., W. M.,  
being located 2640 feet South and 1360 feet East from the NW Corner of Section 14.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as  
follows:

3.6 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
24.5 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$   
4.7 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$   
0.4 acre NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 11  
T. 40 S., R. 8 W., W. M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by the prior  
certificate recorded at Page 13855, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right  
Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of orders of the Water Resources  
Director entered on July 13, 1976, approving transfer application No. 3376 and  
entered on April 6, 1976, approving transfer application No. 3131.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the  
water right in reference to ORS 540.610.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established  
by the Water Policy Review Board.
