CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

JOHN C. BROWN

of Rt. 2 Box 2640, La Grande, State of Oregon, 97850, has
a right to the use of the waters of
Catherine Creek

a tributary of Grande Ronde River for the purpose of
irrigating 20.0 acres

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Union County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 8, at page 1; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from 1904;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed three acre feet per
acre in any irrigation season, diverted at a rate of not to exceed one-fortieth
of a cubic foot per second per acre.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 15, T. 4 S., R. 39 E., W. M.,
1330 feet South and 330 feet West from the NE Corner of Section 15.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:

11.0 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
9.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 14
T. 4 S., R. 39 E., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by
an order of the State Engineer entered April 17, 1970, and supersedes certificate
of water right heretofore issued to Frank P. Davis and recorded at Page 6230,
Volume 6, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established
by the Water Policy Review Board. WITNESS the signature of the Water Resources Director, affixed
