CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

E. A. HART

of Enterprise, State of Oregon, 97828, has a right to the use of the waters of Prairie Creek

a tributary of Wallowa River for the purpose of the irrigation of 1.8 acres of land, domestic, and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wallowa County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 5, at page 171; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1889

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre;

The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 7, T. 2 S., R. 45 E., W. M., 700 feet North and 1100 feet West from the SE Corner of Section 7.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.8 acres Lot 7 Section 6 T. 2 S., R. 45 E., W. M.

An order of the Water Resources Director entered May 28, 1976 approved a change in point of diversion for the irrigation of 8.2 acres. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right not involved in the change and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to E. A. Hart recorded at Page 3047, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
