CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

of Rt. 4 Box 142, Hillsboro , State of Oregon, 97123 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream

a tributary of Tualatin River irrigating 15.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 18332 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 22, 1948

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount equally beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.14 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE' NE', Section 21, T. 1 S., R. 3 W., W. M., 560 feet South and 790 feet West from the NE Corner of Section 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited toone-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

15.0 acres SW NE NE Section 21
T. 1 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion and place of use approved by an order of the State Engineer entered January 12, 1976, and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to Henry Newman, and recorded at Page 22169, Volume 16, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
