CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

of Rt. 2 Box 1, Banks , State of Oregon, 97106 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of West Fork Dairy Creek

a tributary of Tualatin River irrigating 45.5 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 13480 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 8, 1939

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.57 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW% NE%, Section 36, T. 2 N., R. 4 W., W. M., 380 feet South and 1800 feet West from the NE Corner of Section 36.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited toone-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

23.4 scres SWk NEk 22.1 scres NWk SEk Section 36 T. 2 N., R. 4 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and the remaining right approved by an order of the State Engineer entered January 21, 1971, and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to Henry J. Vander Zanden and recorded at Page 32375, Volume 24, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
