of Rt. 1, Forest Grove , State of Oregon, 97116 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Carpenter Creek

a tributary of Tualatin River irrigating 25.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 18003 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 17, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.312 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEX NEX, as projected within Andrew Harper DLC 41, Section 12, T. 1 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited toone-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.6 acres Lot 3 (SW4 SE4)

4.1 acres NW NE

5.3 acres SW4 SE4

8.8 acres NE NE

5.2 acres SE4 SE4 Both T Both projected within Andrew Harper DLC 41

An order of the Water Resources Director entered December 16, 1975 approved a change in point of diversion for the irrigation of 1.0 acre. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right not involved in the change and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to the Estate of Ferdinand Lemcke recorded at Page 20206, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
