CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That**HENRY S. MEARS**

17015 Upper Boone's Ferry Road
of **Rt. 1 Box 271** **Tigard**, State of **Oregon, 97223**, has made
proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of
Fanno Creek

a tributary of **Willamette River** for the purpose of
irrigating 1.7 acres

under Permit No. **23771** and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in
accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from
July 7, 1955
that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.02 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the **NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 13, T. 2 S., R. 1 W., W. M.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to
a diversion of not to exceed **2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre** for each acre irrigated during
the irrigation season of each year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right
is appurtenant, is as follows:

**1.7 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 13
T. 2 S., R. 1 W., W. M.**

An order of the Water Resources Director entered May 10, 1976 approved a change
in point of diversion for the irrigation of 9.3 acres. This certificate is issued
to confirm the remaining right not involved in the change and supersedes the
certificate heretofore issued to Henry S. Mears recorded at Page 28498,
Volume 20, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies
established by the Water Policy Review Board.
