CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOHN MAGEE

of Rt. 2, McMinnville, State of Oregon, 97128, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director of a right to the use of the waters of Baker Creek

a tributary of Yamhill River
irrigating 40.1 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 17115 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 25, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.31 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Wm. Dawson DLC 43, Section 13, T. 4 S., R. 5 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

An order of the Water Resources Director entered December 12, 1975 approved a change in points of diversion for the irrigation of 19.9 acres. This certificate is issued to confirm the remaining right not involved in the change and supersedes the certificate heretofore issued to John Magee recorded at Page 16819, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
