of 5050 Whitmore Ave., Talent , State of Oregon, 97540 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a well

a tributary of Coleman Creek supplemental irrigation of 2.0 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. **G-4590** and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **May 13, 1969**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.03 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 13, (SW, SEX), Section 17, T. 38 S., R. 1 W., W. M., 10 feet North and 1180 feet East from the Sk Corner of Section 17.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one—eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per scre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; and shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.1 acre SWx SE% 0.2 acre Lot 13 (SWk SE%) Section 17 0.8 acre Lot 2 (NWk NE%) 0.9 acre Lot 9 (NWk NE%) Section 20 T. 38 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
