CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

ESTATE OF GERALD MORGAN

of Rt. 2 Box 172, Monmouth , State of Oregon, 97361 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, spring, and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-47507, Permit No. R-5723

a tributary of North Fork Pedec Creek for the purpose of domestic use for one family, stock, and irrigation of 0.1 acre

under Permit No. 35582 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the luws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from

September 8, 1970
that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second, being 0.005 c.f.s. for domestic use from spring, 0.01 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.005 c.f.s. for stock from stream and reservoir

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NEx SD1, Section 17, T. 9 S., R. 6 W., W. M., Spring-2340 feet South and 400 feet West; Reservoir-2170 feet South and 530 feet West from the NE Corner, SEX NEX, Section 17.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightiath of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-5723;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic Use, Stock, and 0.1 acre NE's SE's Section 17 T. 9 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
