CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **FRANK H. AND IRIS G. TANKERSLEY**

of Rt. 1 Box 301, Cornelius, State of Oregon, 97113, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of a reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-1518

a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation of 62.9 acres

under Permit No. 30505 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 26, 1965 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 63.0 acre feet

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Rice DLC 64, Section 19, T. 1 S., R. 2 W., W. M., 520 feet South and 950 feet East; 1000 feet South and 1050 feet East; both from the NW Corner, Rice DLC 56.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ~~of one cubic foot per second per acre,~~ a diversion of 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.0 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
 4.0 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
 8.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
 16.2 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
 33.2 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
 0.5 acre NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
 All projected within Rice DLC 64
 Section 30
 T. 1 S., R. 2 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
