that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from November 13, 1885

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1/40 of one autic for per second per acre; and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said acres

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

6 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter; 12 agres in the Northwest quarter of Northeast quarter and 30 acres in the Scuthwest quarter of Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Thirty-four, Township Seven Scuth, Range Forty-one East of Willamette Meridian, in Baker County, Oregon.
