## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

of 16445 SW 92nd, Tigard , State of Oregon, 97223 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stresm

a tributary of Tuelatin River irrigation of 1.6 acres and fire protection

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 31259 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 24, 1966

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second, being 0.02 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.01 c.f.s. for fire protection

or its equivalent in case of rotation measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NN4 NE4, as projected within Richardson DLC 44, Section 14, T. 2 S., R. 1 W., W. M., 1200 feet South and 600 feet East from the N% Corner of Section 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Fire Protection and 0.9 acre NWs NEW Fire Protection and 0.7 acre SWs NEW Both projected within Richardson DLC 44 Section 14 T. 2 S., R. 1 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
