## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

ROBERT EPLER

of Rt. 1 Box 185, Forest Grove, State of Oregon, 97116, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Carpenter Creek and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-43794, Permit No. R-5027 a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation of 18.2 acres and supplemental irrigation of 28.7 acres

under Permit No. 32722 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 10, 1967

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.23 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Creek-NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ; Reservoir-NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ; both within Harper DLC 41, Section 12, T. 1 S., R. 4 W., W. M., Creek-810 feet South and 950 feet West; Reservoir-940 feet South and 1360 feet West; both from the SE Corner of Naylor DLC 37.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-5027 provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein and further limited to the use of stored water only on the lands described as supplemental, and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
