## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

a tributary of Tualatin River irrigation of 13.6 acres

for the purpose of

and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in under Permit No. 34916 accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from February 26, 1970 for 0.013 c.f.s. and April 16, 1970 for 0.157 c.f.s. that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.17 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the scream. The point of diversion is located in the NW, NW, Section 17, T. 2 S., R. 2 W., W. M., 640 feet South and 510 feet East from the NW Corner of Section 17.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acreor its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 24 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> 13.6 acres NWc NWc Section 17 T. 2 S., R. 2 W., W. H.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
