CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FORREST J. HORTON

of Rt. 4 Box 21C, Hillsboro, State of Oregon, 97123, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director of a right to the use of the waters of McFee Creek and reservoir constructed under Application No. R-47873, Permit No. R-5686 a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation of 18.0 acres and fish culture

under Permit No. 35376 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 4, 1971 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.23 cubic foot per second, being 0.22 c.f.s. from creek for irrigation and 0.01 c.f.s. from creek and reservoir for fish culture

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 14, T. 2 S., R. 3 W., W. M., McFee Creek-790 feet South and 150 feet West; Reservoir-340 feet South and 100 feet West; both from the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner of Section 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit No. R-5686,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

16.5 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Fish Culture and 1.5 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 14
T. 2 S., R. 3 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
