CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FRED M. KNOX

of Rt. 1 Box 165, Gaston, State of Oregon, 97119, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream with any deficiency in the available supply from the unnamed stream to be made up by appropriation from an unnamed spring, provided that the * a tributary of Scoggin Creek for the purpose of domestic use for one family

under Permit No. 36236 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 24, 1971 for the unnamed stream & November 28, 1972 for the unnamed spring that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (SW 1/4 SW 1/4), Section 16, T. 1 S., R. 4 W., W. M., Stream-1100 feet North and 1240 feet East; Spring-692 feet North and 1320 feet East; both from the SW Corner of Section 16.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to -----of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Section 16
T. 1 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

* total quantity diverted from both sources shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
