CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That FRANK GUIDO

of Rt. 3 Box 595, Roseburg , State of Oregon, 97470 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of South Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River irrigation of 54.9 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 23462 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 24, 1955

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.69 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 8 (NEL NWL), Section 4, T. 27 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

27.4 acres SW4 NW4 7.4 acres Lot 9 (SE4 NW4) 8.2 acres Lot 10 (NE4 SW4) 11.9 acres NW4 SW4 Section 4 T. 27 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use of water from the South Umpqua River approved by an order of the State Engineer entered December 21, 1973 as well as including the balance of the right not involved in this proceeding and superseder certificate of water right issued to Busenbark Bros. and recorded at Page 28555, Volume 20, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
