CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WALLY MILES

of Umpqua Rt. Box 52 A, Oakland , State of Oregon, 97462 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Calapooya Creek

a tributary of Umpqua River irrigation of 0.3 acre

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 27579 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 6, 1961

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW4 SE4, as projected within Stephens DLC 50, Section 15, T. 25 S., R. 6 W., W. M., 1290 feet South and 2240 feet East from the most westerly NW Corner, Stephens DLC 50.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right to the use of water is limited to the period when the flow of Calapova Creek is more than 12.0 c.f.s. at its mouth,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.3 acre NE% SW%
As projected within Stephens DLC 50
Section 15
T. 25 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by an order of the State Engineer entered January 2, 1974 and together with certificate 40357 supersedes certificate of water right issued to the Estate of Mary K. Forster and recorded at Page 34977, Volume 27, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
