CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CITY OF ROSEBURG

of 744 SE Rose St., Roseburg, State of Oregon, 97470, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of South Umpqua River

a tributary of Umpqua River for the purpose of irrigation of 0.33 acre

under Permit No. 7427 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 9, 1926 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.005 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 14, T. 27 S., R. 6 W., W. M., 4380 feet South and 790 feet West from the NE Corner of Section 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ~~one-eighth~~ one-eighth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.33 acre NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 14
T. 27 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of diversion of water from the South Umpqua River approved by an order of the State Engineer entered December 19, 1973 and together with certificate 40359 supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to P. W. Kay and recorded at Page 7358, Volume 7, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
