## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That

HARRY J. YOUTSEY

of 13785 N. Applegate Rd., Grants Pass , State of Gregon, 97526 , has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of Slagle Creek

a tributary of Applegate River irrigating 28.5 acres

for the purpose of

under Permit No. 10889 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 20, 1933

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.15 cubic foot per second

o its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 2 (NE NW4), Section 6, T. 38 S., R. 4 W., W. M., 420 feet South and 970 feet West from the SE Corner. Davidson DLC 39.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.5 acres Lot 2 (NE% NW%)
15.0 acres Lot 3 (NW% NW%)
10.0 acres Lot 4 (SW% NW%)
Section 6
T. 38 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered May 13, 1968, and together with State Engineer Special Order Volume 18, Page 463, supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to L. A. Wilcox, and recorded at Page 11198, Volume 10, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
