CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That BEULAH INGALLS AND MARY ANN TURNER

of 8510 Redwood Hwy., Wilderville, State of Oregon, 97543, has
a right to the use of the waters of
Slate Creeka tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of
irrigation of 10.0 acresand that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Jackson County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of
the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at page 1; that the priority of the
right thereby confirmed dates from 1898;that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.25 cubic foot per
second.The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 1, T. 37 S., R. 7 W., W. M.,
1070 feet South and 570 feet East from the NW Corner, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 1.A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as
follows:10.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 1
T. 37 S., R. 7 W., W. M.This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved
by an order of the State Engineer entered May 11, 1967, and supersedes
certificate of water right heretofore issued to Oliver Morrison and recorded
at Page 16262, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates.And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies
established by the Water Policy Review Board. WITNESS the signature of the Water Resources Director, affixed
