CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **BEULAH M. INGALLS AND MARY ANN TURNER**

of **8510 Redwood Hwy., Wilderville**, State of **Oregon, 97543**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of **Minnie Creek, a branch of Slate Creek**

a tributary of **Applegate River** for the purpose of **irrigation of 10.0 acres and stock use**

under Permit No. **3284** and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **December 15, 1916**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.23 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 1, T. 37 S., R. 7 W., W. M., 50 feet South and 670 feet East from the NW Corner, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 1.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation; balance for stock;

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

**10.0 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
 Section 1
 T. 37 S., R. 7 W., W. M.**

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the State Engineer entered May 17, 1968, and supersedes certificate of water right heretofore issued to **Fannie A. Morrison** and recorded at Page 28, Volume 4, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
