CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That NORTHWEST LIGHT & POWER COMPANY

of Spokane, State of Washington, has a right to the use of

the waters of Wind Fruit or Fret Creek, Pole Creek, McCulleys Fork, Downie Lakes, O'Ferrels Gulch, tributary of Powder River, and Powder River, tributary of Snake River, for the purpose of Municipal, Domestic, Power, Irrigation, and Manufacturing,

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker, County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume six, at page 291; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from May 15, 1895, for 37.5 sec.ft. from wind Fruit or Fret Creek, and 12.5 sec.ft. from Pole Creek, for municipal, domestic, power, irrigation, and manfg.; 1903 for 10 sec.ft. from Powder River for development of 409 H.P.; 1873 for 15 sec.ft. from McCulleys Fork and Downie Lakes, and Aug. 1, 1904, for 5 sec.ft. from O'Ferrels Gulch for municipal, domestic, power and manfg. that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not ~~exceed~~ be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Within the corporate limits of the City of Sumpter, Baker County, Oregon, for municipal, domestic, and irrigation, and at the Company's power plant for power purposes.
