under Permit No. 34653 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 14, 1969 for 0.5 c.f.s. and January 26, 1970 for 0.5 c.f.s. that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SWz NWk, Section 23, T. 3 S., R. 1 E., W. M., 700 feet North and 2700 feet West from the SE Corner, Alprey DLC 37.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to—————of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
