CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WM. P. SCALLON

of Rt. 2 Box 1048, Roseburg, State of Oregon, 97470, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of two springs and Umpqua River

a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of domestic use for two families and irrigation of 6.8 acres

under Permit No. 36229 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 24, 1971

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.10 cubic foot per second, being 0.07 c.f.s. from spring No. 1 and 0.01 c.f.s. from spring No. 2 for irrigation with any deficiency in the available supply from either spring to be made up by appropriation from Umpqua River provided that the * or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the Springs No. 1 and No. 2-SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 5; River-SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 6, T. 26 S., R. 6 W., W. M., Spring No. 1-1800 feet South and 140 feet East; Spring No. 2-2240 feet South and 670 feet East; River-1960 feet South and 300 feet West; All from the NW Corner of Section 5.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

* total quantity diverted from all sources shall not exceed 0.08 c.f.s. and 0.01 c.f.s. from each spring for domestic use.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

5.2 acres Lot 1 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Domestic Use and 0.8 acre Lot 2 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 5

Domestic Use and 0.8 acre Lot 1 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 6
T. 26 S., R. 6 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
