CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That NOBLE STANDLEY

of **Box 505, Camas Valley**, State of **Oregon, 97416**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of **Middle Fork Coquille River**

a tributary of **Coquille River** for the purpose of **stock and irrigation of 24.3 acres**

under Permit No. **36985** and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **June 12, 1972**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.31 cubic foot per second, being 0.01 c.f.s. for stock and 0.30 c.f.s. for irrigation**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 18, T. 29 S., R. 8 W., W. M., 610 feet North and 1460 feet West from the SE Corner of Section 18.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;**

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

**0.7 acre SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Stock and 6.8 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Both projected within Patterson DLC 40
Section 18**

**14.8 acres NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
2.0 acres NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Both projected within Patterson DLC 40
Section 19
T. 29 S., R. 8 W., W. M.**

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described and is subject to the existing minimum flow policies established by the Water Policy Review Board.
