## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

**This Is to Certify, That FRANCIS E. AND RITA E. CALLAGHER**

of 1900 Beacon Drive, Eugene, State of Oregon, 97402, has made proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director, of a right to the use of the waters of four wells

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation of 140.4 acres

under Permit No. G-3832 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 13, 1967

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.75 cubic feet per second, being 0.40 c.f.s. from Well #1, 0.47 c.f.s. from Well #2, 0.54 c.f.s. from Well #3, and 0.34 c.f.s. from Well #4,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the Well #1 & Well #3-SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ; Well #2-SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ; Well #4-SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 26, T. 14 S., R. 5 W., W. M., Well #1-1600 feet South and 930 feet West; Well #2-2600 feet South and 1620 feet West; Well #3-2600 feet South and 600 feet West; Well #4-1470 feet South and 1100 feet East; all from the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Corner of Section 26.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
