under Permit No. G-5194 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 19, 1971

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.56 cubic feet per second, being 0.74 c.f.s. from Well #414, 0.51 c.f.s. from Well #415, 0.51 c.f.s. from Well #418, and 0.80 c.f.s. from Well #421

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the ell #414-SW. MEL, Wells #415 & #418-NW. SEZ, Section 26, Well #421-Lot 5 (SW. SEZ), Section 23, T. 9 S., R. 4 W., W. M., Well #414-230 feet South and 980 feet West, Well #415-1960 feet South and 1750 feet West, Well #418-2000 feet South and 1940 feet West, Well #421-1900 feet North and 1780 feet West, all from the SW Corner, Wood DLC 55.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited toone-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year;

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
